

Patch International Inc. Announces Corporate Continuation into Canada and Change to Board of Directors

CALGARY, AB – September 4, 2008 – Patch International Inc. (OTCBB:PTCH) ("Patch" or the "Company") announces that Mr. Michael S. Vandale has resigned from the Board of Directors of Patch to pursue other business opportunities. Patch wishes to thank Mr. Vandale for his past involvement as a director and officer of Patch.

Patch is pleased to announce that it has moved its jurisdiction of incorporation from Nevada to Alberta, Canada (the "Continuation into Canada"). Patch took this action pursuant to the vote of its stockholders at its May 30, 2008 special meeting called for the purpose of voting on the Continuation into Canada.

As a result of the Continuation into Canada, Patch will be considered a "foreign private issuer" under the rules and regulations of the Securities and Exchange Commission.

We expect Patch's symbol to change as a result of the Continuation into Canada, indicating that Patch is a foreign issuer. Patch will continue to be quoted on the Over-the-Counter Bulletin Board under the symbol "PTCH" until we receive the new symbol.

In connection with the Continuation into Canada, Patch has replaced its transfer agent with Computershare Trust Company of Canada.
